ATHENS COUNTY RESIDENTS ONLY!

Tires will be accepted Saturday April 15, 2017
from **8:00 AM-2:00 PM**

Requirements:

No tires exceeding 54 in. in height and/or 16 in. in width

All Tires must be free of water, dirt and mud

No tires will be accepted from tire shops, dealers, or repair shops



By state law, individuals may not transport more than ten (10) tires per load without being a registered scrap tire transporter with the State of Ohio. If you are transporting more than ten (10) tires without a permit, you may be subject to a traffic stop and investigation by law enforcement.
