**Tires will be accepted for a FEE only: Cash or Check {No Credit or Debit Cards}**

Passenger & Lt Trk tire	{no rim}	\$0.50
Passenger & Lt Trk tire	{with rim}	\$3.50
Large Trk/Semi tire	{no rim}	\$5.00
Agricultural tire	{no rim}	\$15.00

**Saturday October 19, 2019 - from 9:00 AM-1:00 PM**

*Only one Recycling Semi-Trailer is available per event so space is limited.*

*Once it is full no more tires will be accepted {First come, first serve}*

### **Requirements:**

No racing tires, No Lg Trk/Semi with rims or Agricultural tires with rims accepted

All Tires must be free of water, dirt and mud – **10 Tire Limit per trip**

**No tires will be accepted from tire shops, dealers, or repair shops**



By state law, individuals may not transport more than ten (10) tires per load without being a registered scrap tire transporter with the State of Ohio. If you are transporting more than ten (10) tires without a permit, you may / will be subject to a traffic stop and investigation by law enforcement.
